

HAWKING AND PEDDLING ORDINANCE

Enacted July 26, 1936

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in the business of hawking and peddling goods, wares and merchandise within the limits of the Town of Norway, excepting in the following classes; fish, farm, dairy or orchard products of their own production, bark, wood or forest products and newspapers and religious literature; without first obtaining a license from the municipal officers of the Town of Norway after paying a license fee therefor in the sum of fifty dollars.
2. Any person offending against this provision shall be subject to a penalty not to exceed fifty (50) dollars fine or imprisonment in jail not to exceed thirty (30) days, or both.
